

## Memorandum of Understanding between ESA and PSA

In recognition of the common missions of the European Society for Agronomy (ESA) and Polish Society for Agronomy (PSA), it is hereby mutually understood that a specific cooperative relationships among these two Societies will be established and implemented commencing in the year 2005. Primary areas of cooperation would include the following:

- 1) Mutual cross linkage to WWW home pages to encourage the members awareness of mutual objectives and programmes.
- 2) Exchange of information to include ESA Newsletters and PSA journal Fragmenta Agronomica among officers of the respective Societies to enhance collaborative activities.
- 3) PSA members who will join ESA will be granted half annual normal fee.
- 4) Explore mutually helpful activities such as provide and ESA exhibit at PSA general meetings and vice versa.
- 5) According to the number of PSA members joining ESA, ESA may grant one or more free registrations at the ESA meetings. PSA will designate young researchers for this purpose.

Implementation of these cooperative activities will proceed in accordance of each Societies policies and procedures, and it might be integrated by updating this memorandum of understanding.
